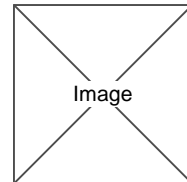
Design Annotations

- 1. Facebook Fan Page:** Applications also have a Facebook fan page, which is automatically generated by Facebook. The fan page provides a forum for discussions and viral communication. Facebook users can "become a fan" of the application this way.
- 2. Link to Application:** A link to the application is provided.
- 3. Fan Page Features:** Additional features of the fan page include an active wall where users can discuss the application, an info section describing the application, a photos section, and so on.
- 4. Wall Comments Disabled:** Wall comments can be disabled so that visitors/fans cannot leave comments on the fan page wall. However, the fan page administrator can still post content to the wall.

- 1. Allow Access:** Upon first entering the application, visitors must allow the application to access some of their profile information. This prompt will appear, requiring visitors to allow this access. Most Facebook applications display a similar prompt to first-time visitors.
- 2. Personal Information Required:** In order to work properly, the application must have access to some personal information. This area will display a summary of the information it needs to access.
- 3. Link to Fan Page and Description:** A link to the application fan page will be provided. A brief description of the application will also be displayed here, as well as the current rating.
- 4. Allow or Leave Application:** The "Allow" button will direct visitors to the application. The "Leave Application" link will send visitors back to the Facebook home page (this is standard behavior for the "Leave Application" link within Facebook).

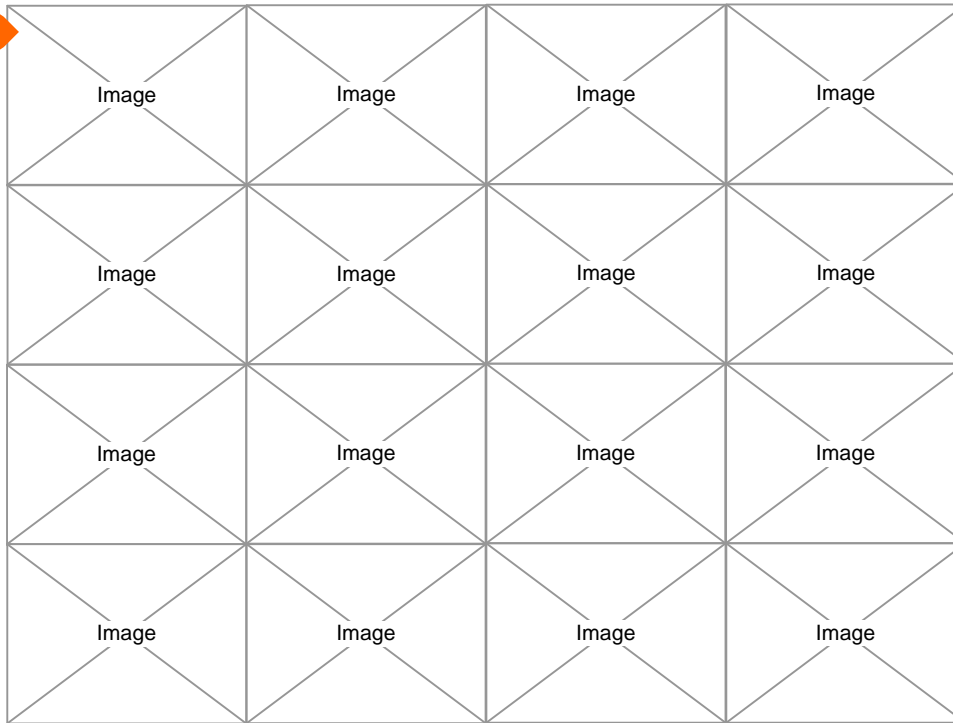

### Design Annotations

**1. Sample Quilt:** Once visitors enter the application, this intro page will be displayed, which includes a sample quilt. This sample quilt is not interactive and for display/illustration purposes only.

This page will appear only to first-time visitors. Returning visitors will be directed to the Chemo Quilt creation page upon entering the application.

**2. Brief, Descriptive Copy:** Concise but comprehensive copy should briefly describe the application functionality and set expectations for visitors.

**3. Call to Action:** A button with strong call to action should direct visitors to begin using the application.

## Design Annotations

**1. Patch Selection:** Visitors may drag and drop patches from the "Choose Patches" area onto the quilt preview. A proper label such as "Choose Patches" and instructive microcopy "Drag items below onto the quilt" is crucial for communicating the intended functionality.

**2. My Photos, Standard Images, and Colors:** Visitors may choose from their own photos (photos they have uploaded to their Facebook photo albums), standard (stock) images, or colors. As visitors navigate through tabs, transition between tabs should be fast and seamless.

As of this writing, these tabs (categories) and their labels may change based upon input from the creative team.

**3. Album Selection:** A dropdown menu will contain all of the visitor's photo albums on Facebook. This will allow visitors to view their photos by album. By default, the dropdown menu should display the "Profile Pictures" album.

**4. Drag and Drop Photos/Color Swatches:** Visitors may drag any photo/color swatch located within these tabs to the quilt preview area (drag and drop functionality is detailed later in this document).

**5. Quilt Preview:** The quilt will consist of 16 patches, with four rows and four columns. Each patch as well as the full quilt will employ a 4:3 aspect ratio. These patches are 120 pixels wide by 90 pixels high. This quilt is 480 pixels wide by 360 pixels high. Displaying a larger quilt preview is not recommended, as screen real estate is limited. When the quilt is rendered/created and saved to visitor photo albums, it may be larger, but the aspect ratio must be retained.

**Pre-Populated with Photos/Color Swatches:** When visitors create a quilt, the quilt patches should be pre-populated with a random selection of their personal photos and at least one standard image (stock photo) and color swatch. Visitors can then edit/change the patches as they wish. Displaying a "blank" quilt and requiring visitors to fill each patch is not recommended.

**6. Finish Quilt:** At any time, visitors may complete their quilt by using the "Finish Quilt" button. A prompt will appear, notifying visitors that they cannot edit or change a quilt once it is finished. This prompt will be detailed later throughout this document.

**7. Randomize Quilt Patches:** Visitors may update the quilt with a random selection of their photos, standard images (stock photos), and color swatches. Similar to the Finish Quilt functionality, a prompt will appear, informing them that this cannot be undone. This prompt will be detailed later throughout this document.

**8. Caption:** Visitors may add a caption to their quilt. This functionality is optional. This caption will appear with the photo once it is saved to a Facebook photo album in their account. Microcopy should appear below this field, explaining what the caption is.

Because there is no character limit on the photo captions within Facebook, there is no character limit on this field.

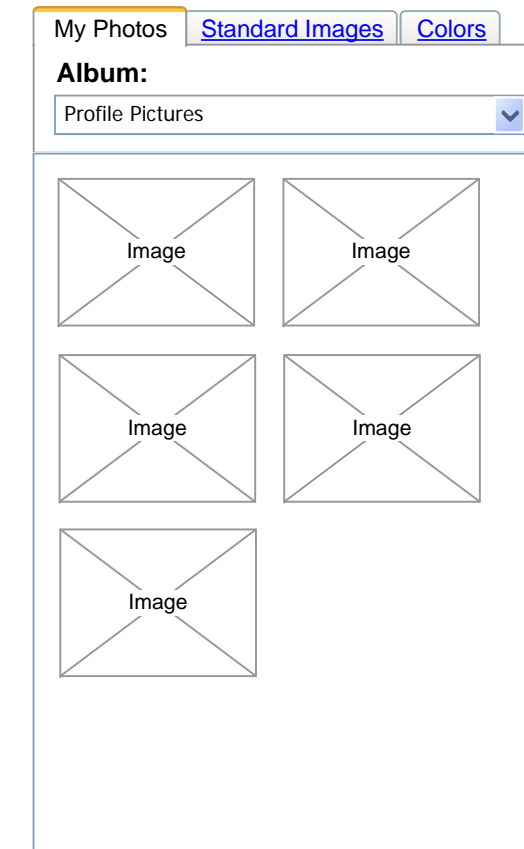
## Design Annotations

**1. No Photos:** It is possible that some visitors will not have any photos associated with their account. If this is the case, an informative message should appear, explaining to visitors that they do not have any photographs. It should also be communicated that once users upload photos to their profile, then return to the application, the photos will be available within the "My Photos" tab.

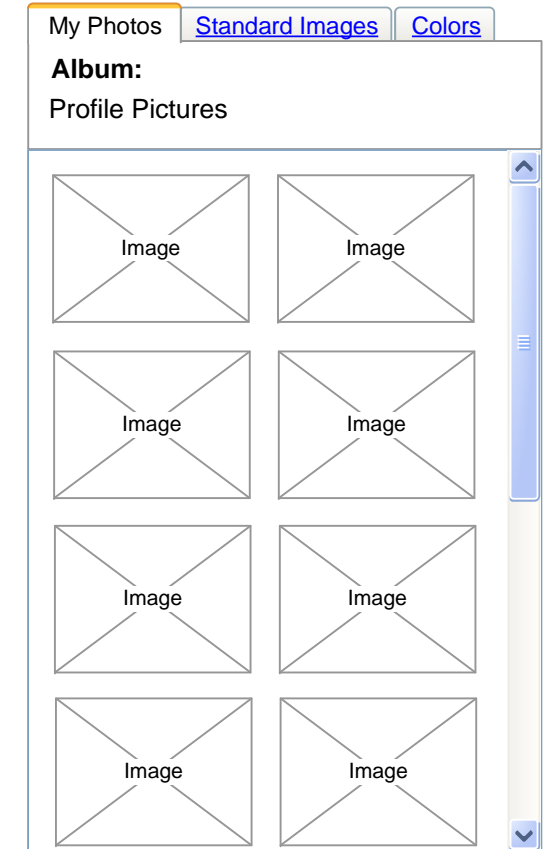
**Scrollbar Enabled Only When Necessary:** Scrollbars will be enabled only if needed. If a visitor's photo album does not have enough photos to necessitate a scrollbar, the scrollbar should not appear (See Figure A below).

**Only One Album Available:** If a visitor's account has only one photo album, a dropdown for photo albums will not be necessary. Instead, the title of the album will be displayed without a dropdown menu (See Figure B below).

*Figure A: A scrollbar is displayed only when necessary.*



*Figure B: If only one photo album exists, a dropdown menu should not be displayed.*

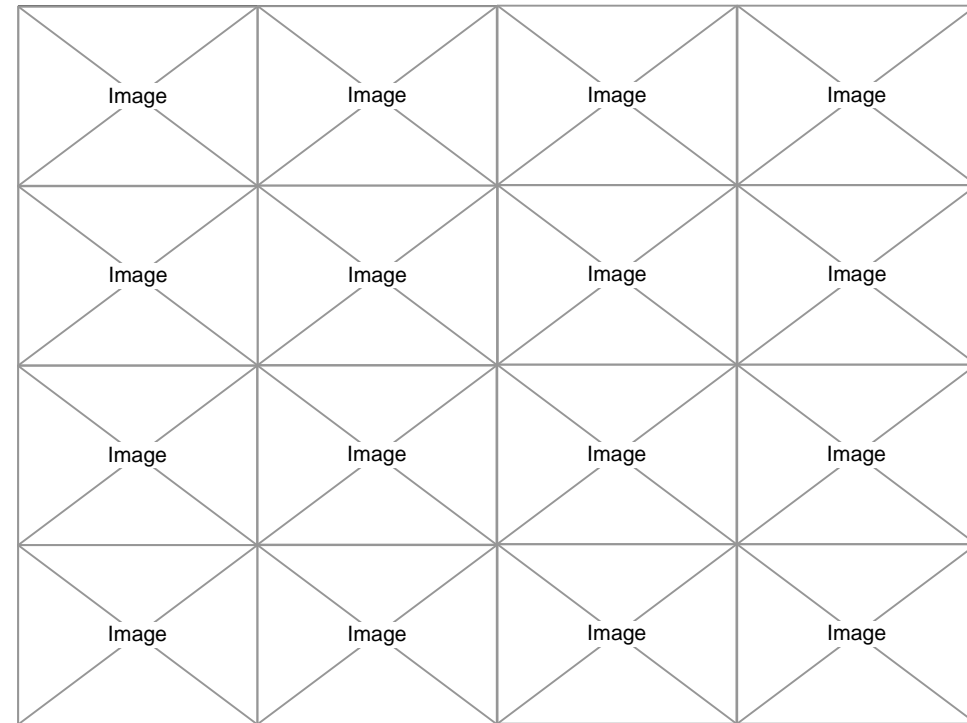

1. **Standard Images/Colors Tabs:** Visitors may access standard (stock) images or color swatches by navigating to the appropriate tab. As of this writing, each tab is intended to contain 32 images or swatches.

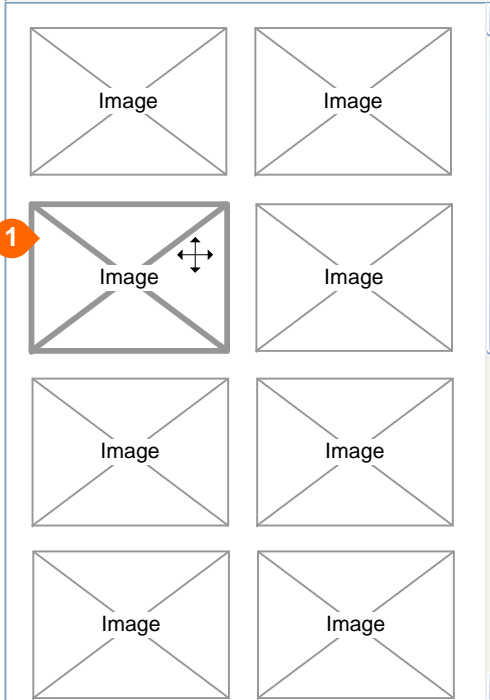

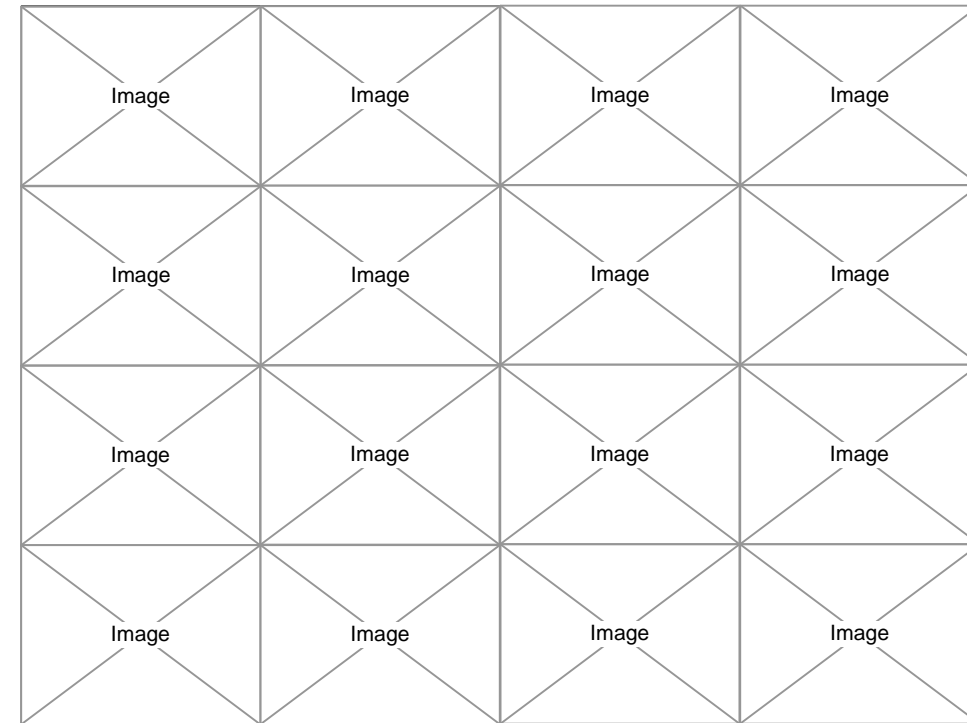

The cursor also changes to a "move" pointer, indicating that the item can be moved or modified in some way.





## Design Annotations

**1. Drag and Drop:** Visitors can click and drag items from the "Choose Patches" area to the quilt preview area. Visitors can drag an item onto any patch within the quilt. Once visitors have dragged the item to the desired patch, they can "release" the item, and the patch should automatically update with the appropriate photo or color swatch.

As illustrated here, the "move" cursor pointer is employed while an item is being dragged.

*Note:* Items cannot be dragged within the quilt. Items can be dragged from the "Choose Patches" area onto the quilt.

**2. Patch Hover State:** As visitors drag an item over a patch, the patch will highlight in some way. Here the highlighted patch is shown with a heavier border and shading.

Visitors may drag items onto any patch. While dragging, the patch covered by the visitor's cursor will be highlighted. Even though visitors may "hold" the item over multiple patches, the location of the cursor determines the target area. When released, the item will be applied to the highlighted patch.

*Note:* If the item is dragged off of the quilt area so that no patches are highlighted, and the visitor "releases" it, it will not be applied to any patches. No changes will be applied.





**3. Continued Dragging:** Unless the item is released, it can be dragged to any patch on the quilt.

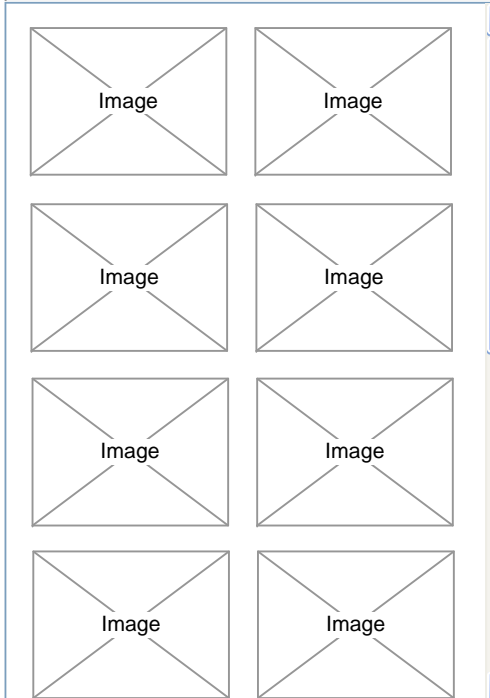

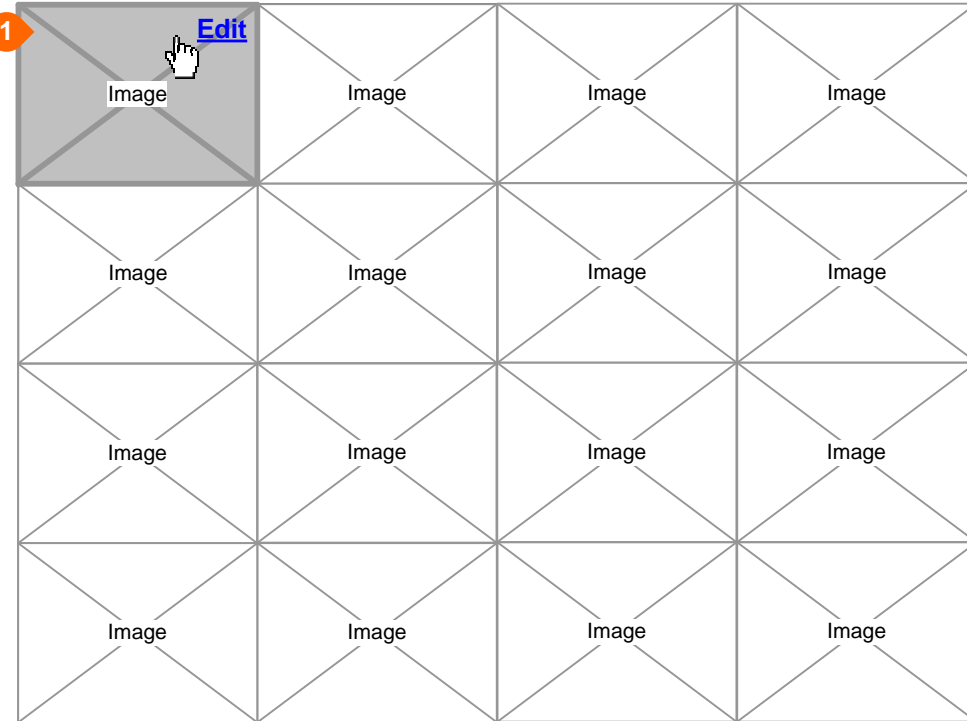

### Design Annotations

**1. Editing a Patch:** Any patch can be edited.\* If visitors hover their cursor above a patch containing a personal photo, an "Edit" hyperlink should appear.

Visitors can click anywhere on this patch to begin the editing process. Doing so will launch an overlay with editing options.

\*If the "Add Message" functionality is enabled, all patches can be edited. However, if this functionality is removed, solid color patches will not be editable. Therefore, hovering over a solid color patch will not produce a hover state, and the patch will not become an active hyperlink displaying the "Edit" call-to-action. Please see further documentation throughout this document regarding the "Add Message" functionality.

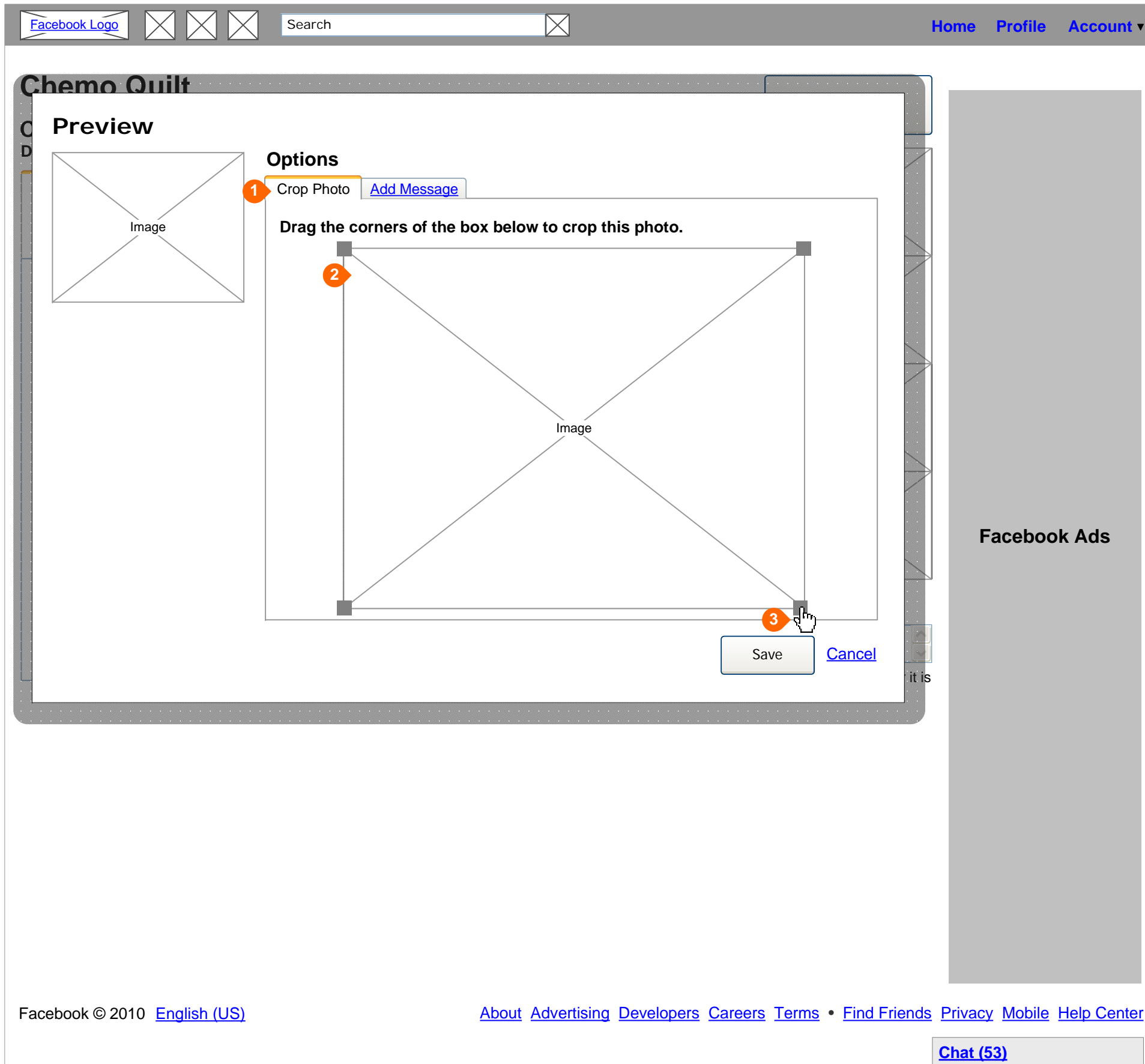

## Design Annotations

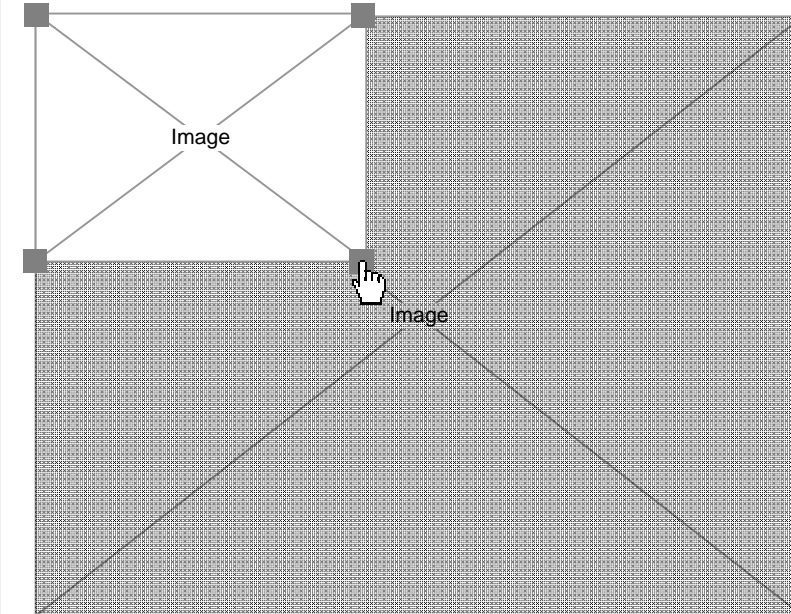
- Edit Patch Overlay:** Visitors can click any quilt patch with a personal photo to edit it and launch this overlay.
- Patch Preview:** As visitors edit the patch within this overlay, this patch image updates in real-time to display their changes.
- Crop Photo or Add Message:** Visitors may add a message to their patch or crop it. Visitors can navigate between tabs to access the appropriate functionality. Note that as visitors navigate between tabs, the transition between tabs should be smooth and quick.
- Save/Cancel:** Visitors may save their changes at any time by using the "Save" button. This will dismiss the window, and the appropriate patch within the quilt will be updated with their changes. Visitors may also cancel their changes at any time. This will dismiss the window but will not apply any changes made to the patch.



Design Annotations

- 1. Crop Photo:** Visitors may crop the photo within the Crop Photo tab. This cropping functionality is based upon the JCrop tool employed by Facebook.
  - 2. Crop Tool:** The full photo associated with the patch is displayed in the background. The crop tool appears above the photo, with draggable icons on all four corners of the photo.
- If the photo employs a 4:3 aspect ratio and landscape orientation, the full photo will be covered initially by the crop area.

Figure A: The 4:3 Aspect Ratio is Maintained

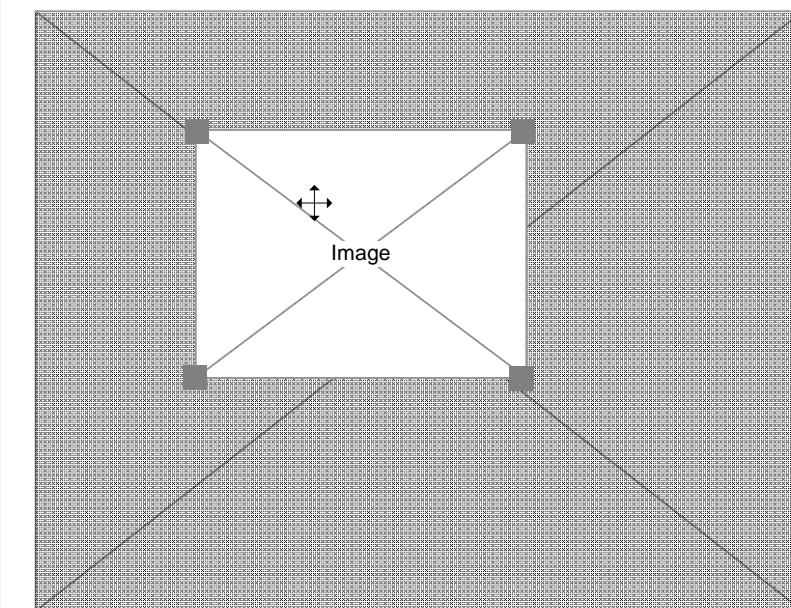


The crop area will maintain a 4:3 aspect ratio. As illustrated below in Figure A, visitors may adjust the size of the crop area, but the tool will always maintain an aspect ratio of 4:3.

As illustrated in Figure B, visitors may drag the crop area around the photo, but the crop area cannot extend beyond the borders of the photo.

The "move" cursor pointer is employed when hovering over the crop area or moving it around.

Figure B: The crop area can be dragged.



**3. Adjustable Corners:** Visitors may adjust the size of the crop area by dragging the corners. Note that the cursor becomes a "Pointer" when hovered over a corner dragging point.

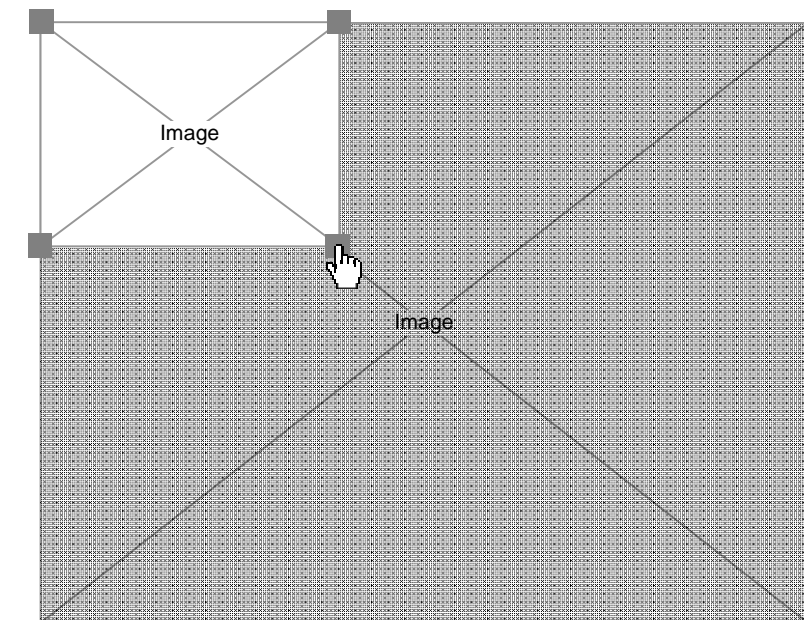
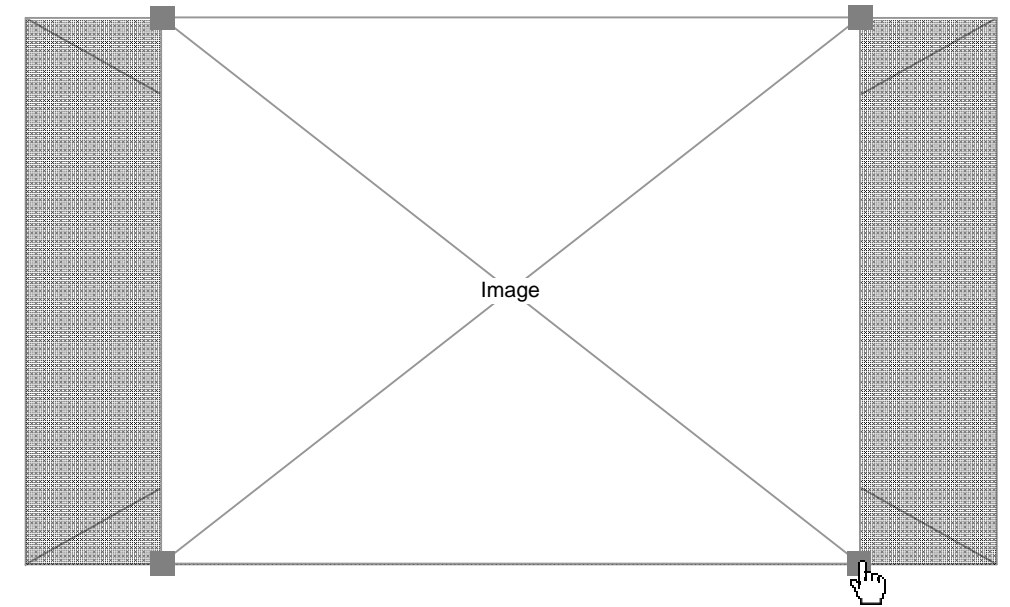

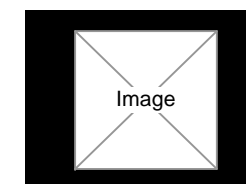
Design Annotations

**1. Photos with Portrait Orientation:** If a photo with portrait orientation is used, the crop area will scale to the width of the photo. Visitors may then adjust the size of the crop area.

**Varying Aspect Ratio:** If a photo with landscape orientation is used, but its aspect ratio is not 4:3, the default crop area will scale appropriately. This example shows how the crop area scales to fit the height of a photo that exhibits an aspect ratio of 16:9.



**Crop Tool Conforms to Minimum Image Size:** Visitors may crop the photo to a minimum size (150px wide is suggested). This will prevent visitors from cropping an image to an extremely small size, which will then have to be up-scaled to fit the quilt. As of this writing, the final quilt is intended to be 600px wide by 448px high, with each patch 150 px wide by 112px high.




**Photos Below Minimum Size:** Since patches in the working version of the quilt are 120x90 pixels, images smaller than this can be auto-centered within the patches and "letterboxed" (surrounded by a solid color/background pattern on top and/or bottom). Letterbox backgrounds will be determined by the creative department. Cropping functionality will not be available for these images.

**RECOMMENDED BUT OUT OF SCOPE:** At the time of this writing, the "Add Message" functionality is out of scope, but it is a recommended feature.

**1. Add Message:** Visitors may add a message to their patch. Once they begin typing, the message should appear immediately on the patch preview to the left.

Due to limited real estate, a character limit for messages must be enforced. This example sets the limit to 75 characters, with a dynamic character counter utility below the text field. As visitors type, the "X characters left" area should update appropriately.

Note that a standard style should be applied to typed messages. For instance, messages could be center justified and displayed in a 12pt sans-serif typeface. Visitors will not be able to control typography, font size, color, etc.

**RECOMMENDED BUT OUT OF SCOPE:** At the time of this writing, the "Add Message" functionality is out of scope, but it is a recommended feature.

If the "Add Message" functionality is omitted from the design, there will be no customization options available for solid color patches. Therefore, this overlay with edit options will not be available for solid color patches, and hovering over a solid color patch will not trigger an "Edit" hyperlink.

**1. Color Patches and Small Images:** If visitors wish to edit a patch that is composed of a solid color swatch, they will only be able to add a message. Crop functionality is not necessary for solid color patches.

Similarly, if visitors have chosen an image from their photos that is too small, cropping functionality should not be allowed. The "Crop Photo" tab should not appear if an image is smaller than 150x112 pixels.

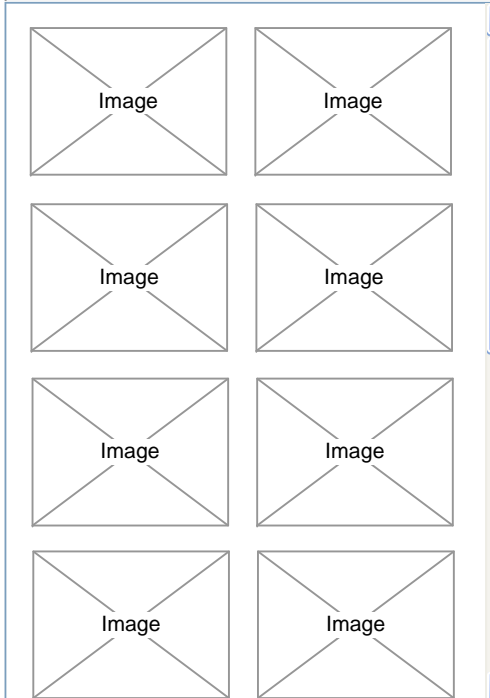

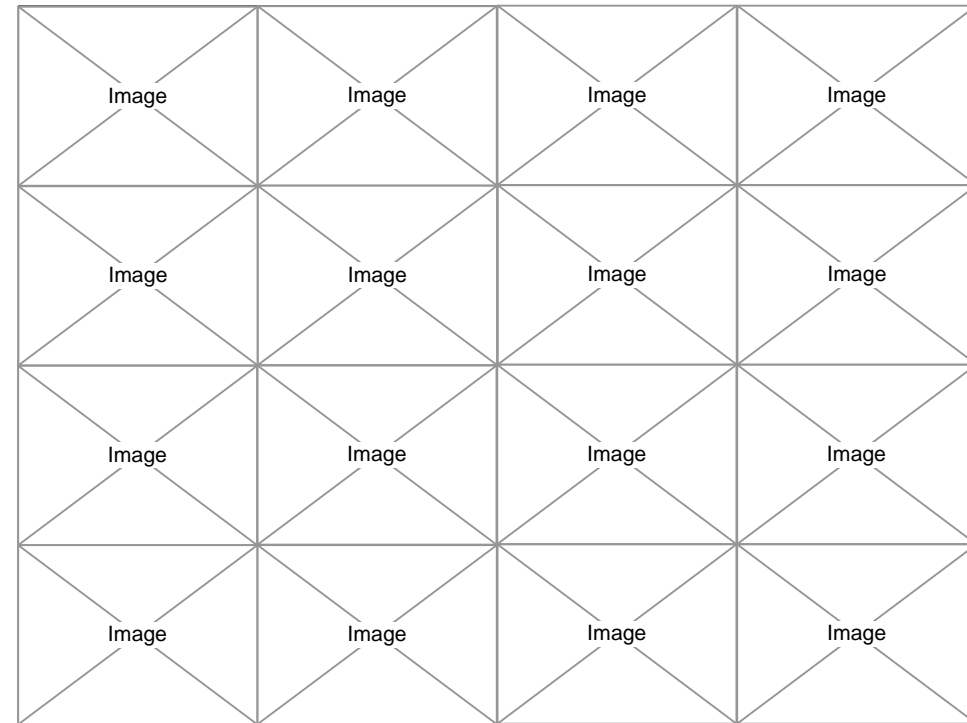

## Design Annotations

**RECOMMENDED BUT OUT OF SCOPE:** At the time of this writing, the "Publish" functionality is out of scope, but it is a recommended feature.

1. **"Publish this Story" Overlay:** If sharing and notifications were in scope, an overlay would appear, asking visitors if they'd like to publish this story.

2. **Default Publication Message:** A brief message would accompany the wall post/notification stating that the visitor has just created a quilt.

3. **Text Field May Be Suppressed:** This text field can be suppressed, preventing visitors from entering text with the notification.

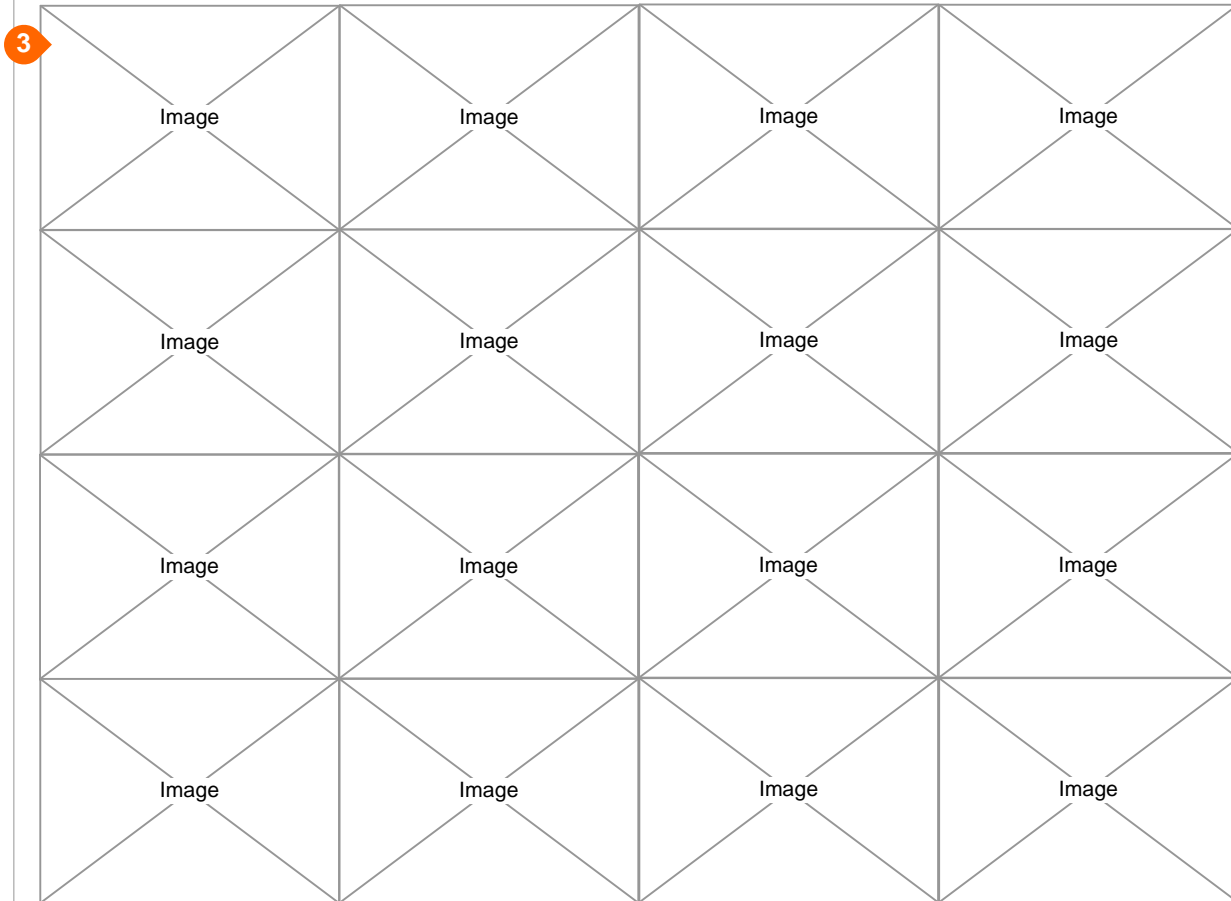
1. **Saving Quilt Progress Bar:** When visitors initiate the process of finishing/saving a quilt, a progress bar will be displayed if time is needed to render/save the quilt.

### Design Annotations

**1. Confirmation Message:** A confirmation message will be displayed. This message will also state that the quilt has been saved as a photo to a new album within the visitor's account.

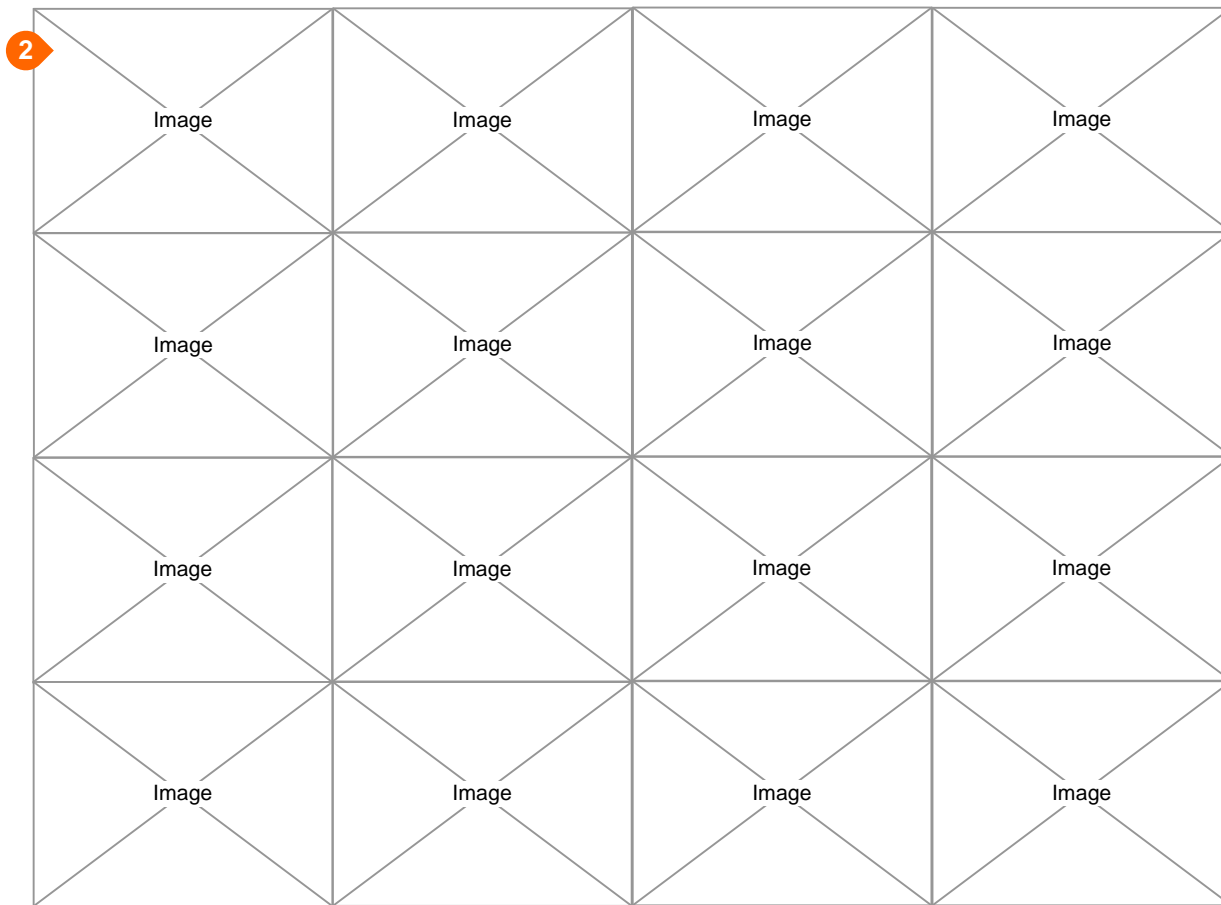
**2. Options:** Once the quilt is finished, visitors may view the quilt in their photo album or create another quilt.


**3. Quilt Preview:** Once the quilt is finished, the final flattened/rendered image is displayed in its actual size. Here the quilt is displayed at 600 pixels wide by 448 pixels high. Each patch is 150 pixels wide by 112 pixels high.

Technical exploration is needed to confirm if up-scaling the final quilt to a larger size is feasible. If up-scaling results in stretching/pixelating the images within the quilt, or if other issues arise, up-scaling should not be employed.

The image should be saved within the visitor's photos in a new album designated for chemo quilts.

**4. [RECOMMENDED BUT OUT OF SCOPE] Share with Friends:** If notifications were in scope, we would allow visitors to share their quilts with friends.

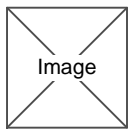

## Design Annotations

**1. Photo Album Created:** When a quilt is finished, a photo of the quilt is saved to the visitor's Facebook profile. If visitors are saving a quilt for the first time, an album should be created within the visitor's photos, and the quilt should be saved to that album. If visitors then create additional quilts, they will be saved to this photo album.

The photo album name should be similar or identical to the name of the app, such as "Chemo Quilt."

**2. Quilt Photo:** The quilt is flattened/rendered into an image and saved as a photo within the visitor's album. While the dimensions of the quilt have yet to be determined, the quilt is displayed here at 600 x 448 pixels.

**3. Caption:** If visitors provided a caption while creating the quilt, it will appear here below the photo.

**4. Promotional Copy in Caption:** In addition to the visitor's custom caption, it is recommended that promotional copy and a link to the application be displayed in the caption. A similar application on Facebook, "Share the Love," displays the following copy within the caption:

"Created on Share the Love. Create your own now! <http://apps.facebook.com/share-love/>"

This aids in promoting the application.

**5. Link to Fan Page:** A link to the application fan page should be displayed here.
